Material

1 ball Gorro kids color 9694 (Mark the monkey) Knitting needles 8

Gauge: 18 S x 20 R = 4"/10 cm over Pattern chart using needles 8.

Disclaimer

Measurements are approximate due to differences between centimeters and inches, needle sizes and tension (gauges).

All care has been taken to allow accurate completion of the pattern.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

st: stitches

CO: cast on

BO: bind off

CN: cable needle

rep: repeat mk: make

dec: decreases inc: increases RS: right side WS: wrong side

K: knit P: purl

1x1 Rib: Row 1: *K1, P1*. Row 2 and all even rows: knit the knit stitches and purl the purl stitches.

Pattern: follow chart


Hat

Start at rib.

CO 75 sts onto needles 8 and work in 1x1 Rib. At 0.75" start following Pattern – chart. Once chart is completed, mk 1 row in k2tog. Cut yarn, leave a long tail and insert this tail into tapestry needle and pass through all loops of last row and pull all loops together.

Finishing: sew side and join pompom animal on top as shown in the picture.
