## Pink Top and Skirt Set

Created by Marcos Filho Level:intermediate

## Material

Circulo Yarns - 1 ball Anne 500 or 2 balls Anne 250 color: \#6133 (Pink)

Circular knitting needles $3 / 3.25 \mathrm{~mm} \mathrm{24"}$ long Tapestry needle Locking stitch markers 2 safety pins
Measuring tape \& scissors

## Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

CO: cast on
BO: bind off
CN : cable needle
rep: repeat
mk: make
dec: decreases
inc: increases
RS: right side
WS: wrong side
K: knit
P: purl
sm: stitch marker
M1R Right-slanting make 1: use the left needle to pick up the strand between the last stitch you knit and the one you're about to knit, bringing the needle from back to front. Insert st onto needle.

M1L Left-slanting make 1: use the left needle to pick up the strand between the last stitch you knit and the one you're about to knit, bringing the needle from front to back. Insert st onto needle.
Garter st - chart 1
Stockinette st (St st) - chart 2

1x1 Rib st - chart 3

Gauge: $13 \mathrm{~S} \times 17 \mathrm{R}=2$ " $/ 5$ cm over Stockinette st using needles 3/3.25 mm

## Skirt

Start at the hemline. Knit in the round.

CO 26 sts onto needles 3 . Rnd 1 - 3: Garter st
Make 10 rnds in Stockinette st and end with 4 rnds in $1 \times 1$ Rib st to form waistline. BO all sts.

## Top

Start at the neckline. CO 16 sts onto needles 3 . Divide Raglan as follows: 1 stitch marker (sm), 2 sts (left back), 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, 2 sts (left sleeve), 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, 4 sts (front), 1 sm, k1 (Raglan
st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, 2$ sts (right sleeve), 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, 2 sts (right back).
Rnd 1: 1 sm (beginning), k2, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k2, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{M1R}, \mathrm{k} 4$, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k2, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{M} 1 \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{k} 2$.
Rnd 2: 1 sm (beginning), k3, $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1$ (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 4$, $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1$ (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 6$, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, k4, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, k3.
Rnd 3: 1 sm (beginning), k3, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k4, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k6, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k4, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k3.
Rnd 4: 1 sm (beginning), k4, $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1$ (Raglan st), 1 sm , k6, $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1$ (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 8$, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, k6, $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1$ (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 4$.
Rnd 5: 1 sm (beginning), k4, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k6, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k8, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k6, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{M} 1 \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{k} 4$.
Rnd 6: 1 sm (beginning), k5, $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1$ (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 8$,
$1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1$ (Raglan st), 1 sm , k10, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, k8, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, k5.
Rnd 7: 1 sm, (beginning), k5, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k8, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{M} 1 \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{k} 10$, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k8, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k5.
Rnd 8: 1 sm , (beginning), k6, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm , k10, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, k12, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 10,1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1$ (Raglan st), 1 sm, k6.
Rnd 9: 1 sm (beginning), k6, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k10, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k12, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k10, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k6.
Rnd 10: 1 sm (beginning), k7, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, k12, $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1$ (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 14,1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 1$ (Raglan st), $1 \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k} 12,1 \mathrm{sm}$, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, k7. End Raglan with these number of sts: 7 sts (left back), 14 sts (12 sts $=$ left sleeve +2 Raglan sts), 14 sts (front), 14 sts (12 sts = right sleeve + 2 Raglan sts), 7 sts (right
back). Slip the 14 sts of each sleeve onto safety pins. Leave the 14 sts of front and the 14 sts of back onto needles $=28$ sts.
Body continuation: Rnd
1-8: work in Stockinette st - chart 2 and rep sts. End with 3 rnds in Garter st chart 1 and rep sts. BO all sts.

## Sleeves continuation:

Left sleeve: Return the 14 sts to needles 3 , inc 1 st on each side $=16$ sts.
Rnd 1-12: work in
Stockinette st - chart 2 and rep sts. Inc 1 st every 2 rnds $(2 x)=12$ sts. End with 3 rnds in Garter st - chart 1 and rep sts.
Right sleeve: same as left.

## InLove Cardigan

## Material

Circulo Yarns - InLove
1 hank color \#3201 (Cameo)
Circular knitting needles 8/5 mm 24" long
Tapestry needle
Measuring tape \& scissors

Pattern A - chart 1

Gauge: $7 \mathrm{~S} \times 15 \mathrm{R}=2$ "/5
cm over Pattern A - chart 1
using needles $8 / 5 \mathrm{~mm}$

## Back

Start at waistline. CO 24 sts
onto needles $8 / 5 \mathrm{~mm}$.
R1-40: Follow Pattern A chart 1 and rep sts. Bind off. Set piece aside.

## Right front

Start at waistline. CO 12 sts onto needles $8 / 5 \mathrm{~mm}$.
R1-40: Follow Pattern B

- chart 2 and rep sts. Bind off. Set piece aside.


## Left front

Start at waistline. CO 12 sts onto needles $8 / 5 \mathrm{~mm}$. R1-40: Follow Pattern C chart 3 and rep sts. Bind off. Set piece aside.

## Shoulder assembly

Use tapestry needle to sew shoulders.

## Sleeves (make 2)

Join yarn at armhole. Pick up 14 sts onto needles 8/5 mm.

R1-12: follow Pattern D chart 4 and rep sts. BO all stitches. Make the other sleeve.

## Finishing

Use tapestry needle to close sleeves (1.25") and sides of body (3.75").

## Material

Circulo Yarns - Charme 1 ball color \#3182 (Pitaya)
Circular knitting needles 6/4 mm 24" long
Tapestry needle
Locking stitch markers
2 safety pins
Measuring tape \& scissors

## Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

st/sts: stitches
CO: cast on
BO: bind off
CN: cable needle
rep: repeat
mk: make
dec: decreases
inc: increases
RS: right side
WS: wrong side
K: knit

sm: stitch marker
M1L: Left-slanting make 1: use the left needle to pick up the strand between the last stitch you knit and the one you're about to knit, bringing the needle from front to back. Insert st onto needle.

M1R: Right-slanting make 1: use the left needle to pick up the strand between the last stitch you knit and the one you're about to knit, bringing the needle from back to front. Insert st onto needle.
$2 \times 2$ Rib st in the round follow chart 1
Pattern in the round (front \& back) - follow chart 2 Sleeves (knit back and forth) - follow chart 3 1/1 LC (LT) - sl 1 st onto cn, hold in front, $k 1, k 1$ from cn 1/1 RC (RT) - sl 1 st onto cn, hold in back, k1, k1 from cn

Gauge: $12 \mathrm{~S} \times 14 \mathrm{R}=2$ " $/ 5$ cm over Stockinette st (knit back and forth) using needles 6/4 mm

## Pattern notes

Check arrows on the measurement chart for direction.

## Dress - Part 1

Part 1
Start at collar.
CO 20 sts onto needles 6. Knit in the round.
Rnd 1-10: $2 \times 2$ Rib st - chart 1 and rep sts.

Insert markers in the last rnd of rib: 1 stich marker (sm) beginning, 3 sts (left back), 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, 2 sts (left sleeve), 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 6 sts (front), 1 sm, k1 (raglan st), 1 sm, 2 sts (right sleeve), 1 sm , k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, 3 sts (right back).
Rnd 11: 1 sm (beginning), 1/1 LC, p1, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, p1, k1, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, p1, 1/1 RC, 1/1 LC, p1, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, p1, k1, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, p1, 1/1 RC.
Rnd 12: 1 sm (beginning), p1, k1, p2, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, p1, k1, p1, k1, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, p1, k1, p1, k1, 1 sm, k1 (Raglna st), 1 sm, p2, k1, p1.
Rnd 13: 1 sm (beginning), k1, 1/1 LC, p1, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k1, p1, k1, p1, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, p1, $1 / 1$ RC, p1, k1, 1/1 LC, p1, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, k1, p1, k1, p1, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, p1, $1 / 1$ RC, p1.

LC, p1, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, (p1, k1) rep 2 more times, M1L, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, M1R, p1, 1/1 RC, k1, p1.
Rnd 16: 1 sm (beginning), p1, k1, p1, k1, p2, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, (p1, k1) rep 3 more times, 1 sm , k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, p2, k1, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p2, 1 sm, k1 (Raglan st), 1 sm, (p1, k1) rep 3 more times, 1 sm, k1 (Raglna st), 1 sm, p2, k1, p2, k1.
End Raglan with these number of sts: 6 ss (left back(, 10 sts (left sleeve), 12 sts (front), 10 sts (right sleeve) and 6 sts (right back). Slip the 10 sts of each sleeve to the safety pin. Leave teh 12 sts of front and the 12 sts of back onto

Rnd 17-42: follow Pattern chart 2 BO all stitches.

## Sleeves continuation

Left sleeve: return the 10 sts onto needles 6. Knit back and forth.
Row 1-10: follow chart 3. BO all sts, leave a tail for sewing.
Right sleeve: same as left. Insert the tail into tapestry needle and close each sleeve.
