**Approx. size:** 5"

**Level:** Intermediate

## Material:

Amigurumi 1 ball color 7563  
Amigurumi Glow 1 ball  
Rubi 1 ball color 7386  
Brown yarn scraps (Amigurumi color 7625)  
Crochet hook C-2  
Tapestry needle  
Polyester stuffing  
White glue  
Optional: blush

## Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st, make: mk, skip: sk, chain: ch  
slip st: sl st, single crochet: sc, double  
crochet: dc, back loop only: BLO  
front loop only: FLO, Increase: inc  
decrease: dec, round: rnd, end of row/  
rnd: eor.

## Body and head

Start with Amigurumi Glow.  
R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.  
R2: 6 inc = 12 sc.  
R3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc  
R4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.  
R5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.  
R6: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.  
R7 - R13 (7 rnds) = 36 sc.  
R14: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc.  
R15: 30 sc.  
R16: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.  
R17 & R18: 24 sc.  
Insert stuffing.  
R19: (BLO) 24 sl sts.  
R20: (FLO - sts of rnd 19): 1 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.  
R21: 2 sc, 1 inc = 48 sc.  
R22: 7 sc, 1 inc = 54 sc.  
Join **Amigurumi color 7563** and work with both strands switching colors on R23 to R34. Switch to **color 7563** in the bold part of pattern below.  
R23: 23 sc, **8 sc**, 23 sc = 54 sc.  
R24: 21 sc, **12 sc**, 21 sc = 54 sc.

R25: 20 sc, **14 sc**, 20 sc = 54 sc.  
R26: 19 sc, **16 sc**, 19 sc = 54 sc.  
R27 - R30: (4 rnds) = 54 sc.  
R31: 19 sc, **16 sc**, 19 sc = 54 sc.  
R32: 20 sc, **14 sc**, 20 sc = 54 sc.  
R33: 21 sc, **12 sc**, 21 sc = 54 sc.  
R34: 23 sc, **8 sc**, 23 sc = 54 sc.  
Cut **color 7563** and continue working with Amigurumi Glow.  
R35: 54 sc.  
R36: 7 sc, 1 dec = 48 sc.  
R37: 6 sc, 1 dec = 42 sc.  
R38: 5 sc, 1 dec = 36 sc.  
R39: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc.  
R40: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.  
Insert stuffing into head.  
R41: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.  
R42: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.  
R43: 6 dec - 6 sc.  
Fasten off in magic loop method. (Insert tapestry needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close hole).  
Use 2 strands of Rubi color 7386 to embroider eyes with 3 sts (width) onto R29, 6 sts apart and mouth with 2 sts (width) onto R26 as shown in the picture.  
Use Amigurumi 7563 to embroider nose with 2 sts (width) between R28 & R29 as shown in the picture.  
Optional: apply blush onto cheeks.  
Use yarn scraps (Amigurumi 7625) to embroider hair onto R32 to R34 as shown in the picture.  
**Arms (mk 2) and legs (mk 2)** Use Amigurumi Glow.  
R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.  
R2: 6 inc = 12 sc.  
R3 to R7 (5 rnds) = 12 sc.  
Fasten off with a tail for sewing.  
Insert stuffing and sew onto body.  
**Long bandage for head**  
Use Amigurumi Glow.  
Ch 5.  
R1: sk 3 chains (counted as 1 dc), 2 dc = 3 dc.  
Work back and forth.

R2 to R62 (61 rows): ch 2 (counted as 1 dc), 2 dc = 3 dc.  
Fasten off.

## Short bandage for head (mk 2)

Use Amigurumi Glow.  
Ch 5.  
R1: sk 3 chains (counted as 1 dc), 2 dc = 3 dc.  
Work back and forth.  
R2 to R25 (24 rows): ch 2 (counted as 1 dc), 2 dc = 3 dc.  
Fasten off.  
Wrap bandages around head skipping face and secure with pins.  
Sew or glue onto head.  
Note: bandages size and length depends on your choice to wrap around head. If necessary add or take out rows.

## Bandage for body.

Use Amigurumi Glow.  
Ch 5.  
R1: sk 3 chains (counted as 1 dc), 2 dc = 3 dc.  
Work back and forth.  
R2 to R82 (81 rows): ch 2 (counted as 1 dc), 2 dc = 3 dc.  
Fasten off.  
Wrap bandages around body and secure with pins. Sew or glue onto body.

## Bandages for arms and legs (mk 4).

Use Amigurumi Glow.  
Ch 5.  
R1: sk 3 chains (counted as 1 dc), 2 dc = 3 dc.  
Work back and forth.  
R2 to R14 (13 rows): ch 2 (counted as 1 dc), 2 dc = 3 dc.  
Fasten off.  
Wrap bandages around arms and legs, secure with pins. Sew or glue onto body.



# Pumpkin pillow



# Pumpkin pillow

**Size:** 19.75" x 19.75"

**Level:** Intermediate

**Material:**

Natural Cotton 4/6 1 ball color 20  
Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4/6 2 balls  
color 4456 and 1 ball color 5718.  
Crochet hook E-4/3.5 mm  
Polyester stuffing or pillow insert.

**Gauge:** 15 hdc x 10 R = 4"/10 cm using  
Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4/6 and  
hook E-4.

**Stitch glossary and abbreviations:**

stitch: st, make: mk, skip: sk, chain: ch  
slip st: sl st, single crochet: sc, half  
double crochet: hdc, double crochet:  
dc, Popcorn st with sc: mk 4 sc in  
the same base st, take hook off the  
loop and insert in the 1st st and  
pull through making a Popcorn st.,  
Increase: inc, decrease: dec, round:  
rnd, end of row/rnd: eor.

According to the tapestry crochet  
technique, you work with 2 strands

of yarn in each row, switching colors  
according to chart. Work one color  
at a time, while keeping the other  
colors inside the sts throughout the  
work. The color of the yarn is always  
changed in the last yarn over of the  
stitch. In a correct color change, you  
have a dc in a solid color and a new  
color on your hook.

**Chart 1 - Front**

Use Natural Cotton. Crochet back  
and forth.

Ch 74 + 2 to turn.

R1: insert hook into 3rd ch from hook,  
74 hdc.

R2 - R7: ch 2, 74 hdc.

R8: join Natural Cotton Maxcolor  
4456. Use Natural Cotton to start row:  
ch 2, 25 hdc. Switch to color 4456: 1  
hdc, 1 Popcorn st. \*Switch to Natural  
Cotton: 2 hdc. Switch to Natural  
Cotton Maxcolor 4456: 1 hdc, 1  
Popcorn st, 1 hdc, 1 Popcorn st, 1 hdc,  
1 Popcorn st\*. Rep from \* to \* 1 more  
time. Switch to Natural Cotton: 2 hdc.  
Switch to Natural Cotton Maxcolor  
4456: 1 hdc, 1 Popcorn st. Switch to

Natural Cotton: 27 hdc. Continue  
following chart 1, switching colors  
accordingly. Mk sure the Popcorn st  
puff faces front. Cut Natural Cotton  
Maxcolor 4456 and 5718 but do not  
cut Natural Cotton 20.

**Chart 2 - back**

Use Natural Cotton 20 (chart 1)  
Crochet back and forth.

R1 to R48: ch 1, 74 hdc.


Do not cut yarn.

**Chart 3 - Contour**


Use Natural Cotton 20 (chart 2)  
Fold piece in half and join front and  
back. Crochet in the round joining  
both parts. R1: ch 4+ 1 dc in the same  
base st, sk 2 base sts, \*1 sc, ch 3, 1 dc  
in the same base of previous sc, sk  
2 base sts\*. Rep from \* to \* around  
3 sides. Insert stuffing or pillow and  
close last side. End with 1 sl st. Fasten  
off and weave in ends.


Ch 74 + 2 to turn.

**Size:** 11.25" tall (with hat)

**Level:** Challenging

## Material:

Amigurumi - 1 ball in each color:  
7563/7220/6614/2856/8797 and 8001.  
Charme - 1 ball in each color:  
8990/8001 and 3182  
1 pair of brown safety eyes 10 mm  
Crochet hook D-3.  
Circular knitting needles 3  
Tapestry needle  
Silicon glue  
1 glue gun stick (3.25")  
1 duck bill clip 45 mm  
2 small navy blue buttons  
Sewing thread - colors navy blue and  
purple (similar to color 6614)  
3 snap on buttons 8.5 mm  
12" of navy blue tulle  
Polyester stuffing

## Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st, make: mk, skip: sk, chain:  
ch, slip st: sl st, single crochet: sc, half  
double crochet: hdc, double crochet:  
dc, triple increase: 3 sts in the same  
base st, Puff st with 4 loops, **Knitting**  
**stitches:** CO: cast on, BO: bind off  
CN: cable needle, rep: repeat, mk:  
make, yo: yarn over, dec: decreases  
inc: increases, RS: right side, WS:  
wrong side, K: knit, P: purl, Garter  
Stitch: Knit or purl every row. Every 2  
rows = 1 ridge.

## Left arm

Use Amigurumi 7563. Crochet in the  
round.  
R1: 6 sc inside magic ring.  
R2: 6 inc = 12 sc  
R3 & 4: 12 sc.  
R5: 6 sc, 1 Puff st, 5 sc = 12 sts.  
R6: 12 sc.  
R7: 2 sc, 1 dec = 9 sc.  
R8 to 10 (3 rnds) = 9 sc.  
Insert stuffing into hand making it  
firm.  
R11 - 20: (10 rnds) = 9 sc.  
Insert stuffing until half of arm.  
Fasten off.

## Right arm

Use Amigurumi 7563. Crochet in the  
round.  
R1: 6 sc inside magic ring.  
R2: 6 inc = 12 sc  
R3 & 4: 12 sc.  
R5: 1 sc, 1 Puff st, 10 sc = 12 sts.  
R6: 12 sc.  
R7: 2 sc, 1 dec = 9 sc.  
R8 to 10 (3 rnds) = 9 sc.  
Insert stuffing into hand making it  
firm.  
R11 - 20: (10 rnds) = 9 sc.  
Insert stuffing until half of arm.  
Fasten off.

## Feet and legs. (mk 2)

Start with Amigurumi 8797.  
Ch 6. Around foundation chain.  
R1: sk 1 ch, 4 sc, 1 triple inc into last  
chain, (on the other side): 3 sc, 1 triple  
inc in the same base st of the first sc  
= 12 sc.  
R2: 1 inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, 2 inc = 18 sc.  
R3: 1 inc, 5 sc, 5 inc, 5 sc, 2 inc = 26 sc.  
R4: 26 sl sts (back loop only = BLO).  
Switch to Amigurumi 2856.  
R5: 26 sc (BLO).  
R6 & 7: 26 sc.  
R8: 5 sc, 6 dec, 9 sc = 20 sc.  
R9: 3 sc, 5 dec, 7 sc = 15 sc.  
R10 - 13 (4 rnds) = 15 sc.  
R14: 14 sc to leave strand on back  
center of foot.  
Insert stuffing making foot firm.  
Switch to Amigurumi 7563.  
R15: 15 sc (BLO)  
R16 - 23 (8 rnds): 15 sc.  
Fasten off.  
Insert stuffing making leg firm.  
**Mk second leg.**  
Join Amigurumi 2856 in any front  
loop of R14: ch 3, 14 dc, close with 1 sl  
st into ch 3. Fasten off and weave in  
ends. Use sewing needle and thread  
to sew 1 button onto left side and the  
other on the right side onto this dc  
rnd.  
**Body**  
Start with Amigurumi 8001.  
Join yarn at central sts of left leg

(heels facing you).

R1: 15 sc onto left leg, ch 3, mk 1 sc  
into internal center of the right leg  
(foot facing you) 14 sc = 30 sc.  
R2: 3 sc into chains (insert st maker  
into first sc), 15 sc in the left leg, 3 sc  
in the other side of chain, 15 sc in the  
right leg = 36 sc.  
R3: 1 inc, 1 sc, 1 inc, 15 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc, 1  
inc, 15 sc = 40 sc.  
R4 - 7 (4 rnds): 40 sc.  
Switch to Amigurumi 7563.  
R8 - 10 (3 rnds): 40 sc.  
R11: 1 dec, 1 sc, 1 dec, 15 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc, 1  
dec, 15 sc = 36 sc.  
R12: 36 sc.  
R13: 10 sc. 1 dec = 33 sc.  
R14: 33 sc.  
R15: 9 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc.  
R16: 30 sc.  
Insert stuffing into body.  
R17: 1 dec, 8 sc = 27 sc.  
R18: 27 sc.  
R19: 1 dec, 7 sc = 24 sc.  
Join arms in the next rnd.  
R20: 9 sc into body. Position left arm  
with thumb facing front, mk 1 sc into  
arm internal center, 8 sc in the left  
arm, 12 sc into body. Position right  
arm with thumb facing front, mk 1  
sc into arm internal center, 8 sc into  
right arm and 3 sc into body = 42 sc.

## Neck and head

Continue using Amigurumi 7563.  
R1 & 2: 12 sc.  
R3: 12 inc = 24 sc.  
R4: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.  
R5: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.  
R6: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc.  
R7: 6 sc, 1 inc = 48 sc.  
R8: 7 sc, 1 inc = 54 sc.  
Insert the glue gun stick into body  
and head.  
R9 - 20 (12 rnds) 54 sc.  
R21: 7 sc, 1 dec = 48 sc.  
R22: 6 sc, 1 dec = 42 sc.  
R23: 5 sc, 1 dec = 36 sc.  
R24: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc.  
Insert stuffing into head.  
R25: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.  
R26: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.

R27: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.  
 Insert stuffing until full.  
 Fasten off in magic loop method.  
 (Insert tapestry needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close hole).  
 Use Amigurumi 7563 to embroider nose with 3 sts between R14 & 15.  
 Use Charme 8001 to embroider around eyes and color 8990 to embroider eyelashes as shown in the picture. Use Charme 3182 to embroider mouth with 3 sts onto R10.

## Hair

Use Amigurumi 7220.  
 R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.  
 R2: 6 inc (BLO) = 12 sc.  
 R3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.  
 R4: (BLO) 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.  
 R5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.  
 R6: (BLO) 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.  
 R7: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc.  
 R8: (BLO) 6 sc, 1 inc = 48 sc.  
 R9: 7 sc, 1 inc = 54 sc.  
 Mk 1 lock of hair: 1 sl st, ch 42, sk 1 ch (3 hdc in the same base st)3x, 38 hdc, sk 1 base st. Make a total of 27 locks of hair into R9.  
 Mk sl sts until FL of R7, 5, 3 and 1 and work the same way to make locks of hair but skip 3 base sts and join the next st.

The locks of hair will be on the WS on top of head.

Fasten off, weave in ends and glue on top of head as shown in the picture.  
 Mk 2 chain cords with 70 chains each, one with color 6614 and other with color 2856. Use them to tie hair on the side as shown in the picture.

## Hat


Use Amigurumi 2856.  
 R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.  
 R2: 6 sc.  
 R3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc.  
 R4: 9 sc.  
 R5: 2 sc, 1 inc = 12 sc.  
 R6: 12 sc.  
 R7: 3 sc, 1 inc = 15 sc.  
 R8: 4 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.  
 R9: 18 sc.  
 R10: 5 sc, 1 inc = 21 sc.  
 R11: 6 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.  
 R12: 24 sc.  
 R13: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.  
 R14 & 15: 30 sc.  
 R16: (BLO) 1 sc, 1 inc = 45 sc.

R17: 45 sc.  
 R18: (BLO) 12 sc, 1 inc = 60 sc.  
 Fasten off and weave in ends.  
 Use tapestry needle and Amigurumi 2856 and mk chains starting at top down, sk 1 rnd and 1 st. End at R15.  
 Fasten off and weave in ends.  
 Use Amigurumi 6614.  
 Ch 30. Fasten off and sew onto R15 of hat.  
 Use silicon glue to glue duck bill clip centralized under hat.

## Dress

Use Amigurumi 6614 and circular knitting needles.  
 Knit in the round - top-down - raglan shape.

CO 24 sts.  
 Rnd 1: k2, p3, k1, p2, k1, p6, k1, p2, k1, p3, k2 = 24 sts.



\*Note: Raglan increases are always made onto RS with 1 yo before and after division.

R2: k5, yo, p1, yo, k2, yo, p1, yo, k6, yo, p1, yo, k2, yo, p1, yo, k5 = 32 sts.  
 R3: k2, p4, k1, p4, k1, p8, k1, p4, k1, p4, k2 = 32 sts.  
 R4: k6, yo, p1, yo, k4, yo, p1, yo, k8, yo, p1, yo, k4, yo, p1, yo, k6 = 40 sts.  
 R5: k2, p5, k1, p6, k1, p10, k1, p6, k1, p5, k2 = 40 sts.  
 R6: k7, yo, p1, yo, k6, yo, p1, yo, k10, yo, p1, yo, k6, yo, p1, yo, k7 = 48 sts.  
 R7: k2, p6, k1, p8, k1, p12, k1, p8, k1, p6, k2 = 48 sts.  
 R8: k8, yo, p1, yo, k8, yo, p1, yo, k12, yo, p1, yo, k8, yo, p1, yo, k8 = 56 sts.  
 R9: k2, p7, k1, p10, k1, p14, k1, p10, k1, p7, k2 = 56 sts.  
 BO sleeves in the next rnd.  
 R10: k9 (BO raglan + 10 sts + raglan) 1 remaining st onto right needle, BO this st with 1 st of front, k13, (BO raglan + 10 sts + raglan) 1 remaining st left onto right needle, BO this st with 1 st of back, k8 = 32 sts.  
 R11: k2, p28, k2 = 32 sts.

R12: k32.  
 R13: k2, p28, k2 = 32 sts  
 R14: k9, inc 1 Note: mk all increases as follows: (yo between sts of rnd below.), k14, inc 1, k9 = 34 sts.  
 R15: k2, p30, k2 = 34 sts.  
 R16: k9, inc 1, k16, inc 1, k9 = 36 sts.  
 R17: k2, p32, k2 = 36 sts.  
 R18: k2, (k1, inc 1) 32x, k2 = 68 sts.  
 R19: k2, p64, k2 = 68 sts.  
 R20: k2, (k2, inc 1) 32x, k2 = 100 sts.  
 R21 and all odd rnds up to R37: k2, p96, k2 = 100 sts  
 R22 and all even rnds up to R38: k100.  
 R38: k100.  
 BO all sts knitwise.

## Second skirt

Use Amigurumi 6614 and knitting needles.  
 Pick up 68 sts on the RS between R18 & 19.

R1: k2, p64, k2 = 68 sts.  
 R2: k2, (k2, inc 1) 32x, k2 = 100 sts.  
 R3: k2, p96, k2 = 100 sts.  
 R4: k100.  
 R5: k2, p96, k2 = 100 sts.  
 R6: k100.  
 Join Amigurumi 2856 and do not cut color 6614.  
 R7: k2, p96, k2 = 100 sts.  
 R8: k100.  
 Switch to color 6614, do not cut color 2856.  
 R9: k2, p96, k2 = 100 sts.  
 R10: k100.  
 Switch to color 2856, do not cut color 6614.  
 R11: k2, p96, k2 = 100 sts.  
 R12: k100.  
 Switch to color 6614, do not cut color 2856.  
 R13: k2, p96, k2 = 100 sts.  
 R14: k100.  
 Switch to color 2856, cut color 6614.  
 R15: k2, p96, k2 = 100 sts.  
 R16: k100.  
 BO all sts knitwise.  
 Sew snap on buttons onto back opening.

**Size:** 10.25" diameter

**Level:** Intermediate

## Material:

Amigurumi - 1 ball in each color: 8001, 4456, 4448, 5203, 6614, 6399 and 8990.

White and pink yarn scraps (color 3131 and 8001)

Rubi - 1 ball in each color: 6188, 8001 and 8990.

1 pair of green safety eyes (8 mm)

1 pair of black safety eyes (8 mm)

Crochet hook C-2

Tapestry needle.

Styrofoam wreath 2" x 10.25"

## Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st, make: mk, skip: sk, chain: ch, slip st: sl st, single crochet: sc, half double crochet: hdc, double crochet: dc, dc3tog: 3 dc closed tog in different base sts., Crab st: sc from left to right, Picot: ch 3, insert hook into ch 1, 1 sl st, triple increase: 3 sts in the same base st

## Ghost

### Arms (mk 2)

Use Amigurumi 8001.

R1: 5 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 5 inc = 10 sc.

R3 - 5 (3 rnds) = 10 sc.

Fasten off.

### Body and head

Use Amigurumi 8001.

R1: 4 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 2 inc, 2 sc = 6 sc.

R3: 1 sc, 2 inc, 3 sc = 8 sc.

R4: 1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 hdc inc, 1 hdc, 3 sc = 10 sts.

R5: 2 sc, 1 hdc, 2 hdc inc, 1 hdc, 4 sc = 12 sts.

R6: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.

R7: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.

R8: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.

R9 - 13 (5 rnds) = 30 sc.

R14: 2 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.

R15: 1 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.

Insert stuffing into head.

Join arms in the next rnd.

R16: 2 sc, ch 1, 10 sc into arm, 1 sc into ch. Work on body: 1 inc (2 sc, 1 inc)2x, 2 sc, ch 1, 10 sc into other arm, 1 sc into chain. Work on body: 1 inc, (2 sc, 1 inc)2x = 48 sts.

R17: 48 sc.

R18: 2 sc, 1 dec = 36 sc.

R19: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc.

Insert stuffing into arms.

R20 - 27 (8 rnds) = 30 sc.

R28: (BLO - back loop only) 30 sc.

Insert stuffing into body.

R29 (BLO): 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.

R30: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.

If necessary, complete with more stuffing.

R31: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

R32: 6 dec = 6 sc.

Fasten off in magic loop method.

(Insert tapestry needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close hole).

## Bat

### Body and head.

Use Amigurumi 8990.

R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 6 inc = 12 sc.

R3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.

R4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.

R5 - 10 (6 rnds) = 24 sc.

R11: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.

Insert stuffing into body.

R12: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.

R13: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.

R14 - 19 (6 rnds) = 30 sc.

Attach green safety eyes between rnds 16 & 17, 6 sts apart.

R20: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.

R21: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.

Insert stuffing into head.

R22: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

R23: 6 dec = 6 sc.

Fasten off in magic loop method.

(Insert tapestry needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close hole).

Use Rubi color 6188 to embroider mouth with 4 sts (width) onto R14.

Use Rubi color 8001 to embroider teeth onto R13.

Use pink scraps or color 3131 to embroider cheeks with 2 sts (width) onto R14 & 15.

Use Amigurumi 8001 to embroider eye details.

## Ears (mk 2)

Use Amigurumi 8990.

R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 1 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc.

R3: 2 sc, 1 inc = 12 sc.

R4: 12 sc.

Fasten off.

Sew ears between R18 & 21. Use pink scraps or color 3131 to embroider internal part of ear.

## Wings

Use Amigurumi 8990.

Ch 13.

Crochet back and forth. Ch 1 to start rows.

R1: sk 1 ch, 12 sc.

R2: 1 inc, 10 sc, 1 inc = 14 sc.

R3: 1 inc, 12 sc, 1 inc = 16 sc.

R4: 1 inc, 14 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.

R5: 1 inc, 16 sc, 1 inc = 20 sc.

R6: 1 inc, 18 sc, 1 inc = 22 sc.

R7: 1 inc, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, (1 dc, 1 picot, 1 dc in the same base st, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 8 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, (1 dc, 1 picot, 1 dc) in the same base st, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 inc = 28 sts.

## Wing finishing

Side: 4 dc in the same base st, sk 1 base st on side, 1 sl st, 3 dc in the same base st, sk 1 side st, 1 sl st, (4 dc in the same chain, sk 2 base sts, 1 sl st)3x into initial chains. On the other side: 3 dc in the same base st, sk 1 side st, 1 sl st, 4 dc in the same base st, sk 1 side st, 1 sl st.

Fasten off and sew onto body as shown in the picture.

## Pumpkin

Use Amigurumi 4456.

R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 6 inc = 12 sc.  
 R3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.  
 R4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.  
 R5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.  
 R6: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.  
 R7 - 16 (10 rnds) = 36 sc.  
 Attach black safety eyes between R11 & 12, 6 sts apart.  
 R17: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc.  
 R18: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.  
 Insert stuffing.  
 R19: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.  
 R20: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.  
 R21: 6 dec = 6 sc.  
 Use Rubi color 8990 to embroider eye details and eyebrows (diagonally with 1 st) onto R14 and embroider mouth with 2 sts onto R9 as shown in the picture.

### Pumpkin stem and leaf

Use Amigurumi 5203.  
 R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.  
 R2: (BLO) 6 inc = 12 sc.  
 Fasten off.  
 Insert hook into front loops and make:  
 R1: 6 sc.  
 R2 to 4 (3 rnds) 6 sc.  
 Fasten off in magic loop method. (Insert tapestry needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close hole).  
 Sew onto top as shown in the picture.

### Pumpkin hat strap

Use Amigurumi 6614.  
 Ch 26, close ring with 1 sl st. Crochet

in the round.  
 R1: ch 2 (counted as 1 hdc), 25 hdc = 26 hdc.  
 Fasten off. Sew or glue onto hat as shown in the picture.

### Spider

Use Amigurumi 8990.  
 R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.  
 R2: 6 inc = 12 sc.  
 R3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.  
 R4: 1 sl st, (ch 6, sk 1 chain, 5 sl sts into chains, 1 sl st into 3rd chain) 4x, 5 sl sts, (ch 6, sk 1 ch, 5 sl sts into chains, 1 sl st into 3rd chain), 4 sl sts.  
 Fasten off.  
 Use Rubi color 8001 and 8990 to embroider eyes and Rubi 6188 to embroider mouth. The spider is suspended and to prevent it to spin rep rnds 1 - 3 on back and embroider eyes and mouth.  
 Cut 1 strand of Amigurumi 8001 to 6", sew or glue onto back.

### Crochet wreath cover

Start with Amigurumi 6399.  
 Ch 28.  
 Crochet back and forth.  
 R1: ch 3 (counted as 1 dc), 1 dc inc into chain 28, 3 dc, (dc3tog)2x, 3 dc, (3 dc in the same base st)2x, 3 dc, (dc3tog) 2x, 3 dc, 3 dc in the same base st = 28 sts.  
 Switch to Amigurumi 4448.  
 R2: ch 1, turn, 28 sc.  
 Switch to color 6614.  
 R3: ch 3 (counted as 1 dc) 1 inc into chain 28, 3 dc, (dc3tog) 2x, 3 dc, (3 dc


in the same base st)2x, 3 dc, (dc3tog) 2x, 3 dc, 3 dc in the same base st = 28 sts.  
 Switch to Amigurumi 8990.  
 R4: ch 1, turn, 28 sc.  
 Rep R1 - 4 up to a total of 92 rows.  
 Fasten off.

### Happy Halloween sign

Use color 8990.  
 Ch 29. Crochet back and forth.  
 R1: sk 1 ch, 28 sc.  
 R2 - 11 (10 rows): 28 sc, ch 1, turn.  
 Switch to color 6614.  
 Mk 1 rnd in sc around sign = 78 sc.  
 Fasten off.  
 Join color 4456 and mk 1 rnd in Crab st = 78 sts. Fasten off.  
 Use Amigurumi 8001 to embroider with 2 sts (width) and 4 sts (height) Happy Halloween (see chart below). Skip 1 st between letters and 1 row between words.  
 Use color 8001 to embroider spider web.

### Assembly and finishing

Put on cover onto wreath. Use stitch markers to secure cover and sew it around wreath. Use colors 6201 and 6614 to close wreath.  
 Sew or glue the pumpkin, ghost, and bat onto wreath as shown in the picture. Sew or glue hat onto pumpkin. Use Amigurumi 8001 to tie spider into crochet wreath. Glue or sew Happy Halloween onto crochet wreath.

**Level:** Intermediate

**Material:**

Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4/6 - 2 balls color: 8990 and 1 ball color 4131.

Green yarn scraps or 1 ball of Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4/6 color 5718

Crochet hook E-4.

**Gauge:** 14 sc x 14 R = 4"/10 cm with Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4/6 and hook E-4.

**Stitch glossary and abbreviations:**

stitch: st, make: mk, skip: sk, chain: ch slip st: sl st, inle crochet: sc, Increase: inc, decrease: dec, round: rnd, end of row/rnd: eor.

**Tapestry crochet**

According to the tapestry crochet technique, you work with 2 strands of yarn in each row, switching colors according to chart. Work one color at a time, while keeping the other colors inside the sts throughout the work. The color of the yarn is always changed in the last 2 loops of the stitch. In a correct color change, you have a stitch in a solid color and a new color on your hook.

**Placemats (mk 2) Chart 1**

Use Natural Cotton Maxcolor 8990. Crochet back and forth. Ch 65 + 1 to turn. R1: insert hook into second ch from hook, 65 sc. R2: ch 1, 65 sc.

R3: join Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4131, start row with color 8990: ch 1, 5 sc, switch to 4131, 5 sc, switch to 8990, 1 sc, switch to 4131, 5 sc, switch to 8990, 32 sc, switch to 4131, 5 sc, switch to 8990, 1 sc, switch to 4131, 5 sc, switch to 8990, 6 sc. Continue following chart 1 switching colors accordingly. Cut colors 4131 and 5718 but do not cut color 8990.

**Chart 2 - Contour**

Crochet in the round. Continue working with color 8990. R1: start at corner, ch 1, 2 sc in the same base st. \*Mk 1 sc into each base st on sides and 3 sc into corners\* rep from \* to \* around placemat. Close with 1 sl st. Fasten off. Work around both placemats.



Polyester stuffing

## Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

slip st: sl st, single crochet: sc, half  
double crochet: hdc, double crochet:  
dc, triple increase: 3 sts in the same  
base st

## Knitting stitches:

Insert stuffing until half full.

Flat and close sides with 5 sc.

Fasten off.

Use Amigurumi 5398 and tapestry  
needle to embroider 2 rows in Chain  
st around sleeves between R9 & 10

R24 & 25: 14 sc.

Switch to color 4456.

R26 & 27: 14 sc.

Mk 2 more sc to take yarn to middle  
of leg.

Switch to color 8990.

R28 & 29: 14 sc.

Switch to color 4456.

R30 & 31: 14 sc.

Switch to color 8990.

R32 & 33: 14 sc.

Switch to color 4456.

R34: 14 sc.

Mk 4 more sc to take yarn to middle

of leg.

Insert stuffing until half full.

Flat and close with 7 sc.

## Body

Start with Amigurumi 4456.

R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 6 inc = 12 sc.

R3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.

R4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.

R5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.

R6: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.

R7: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc.

R8: 6 sc, 1 inc = 48 sc.

Join legs in the next rnd.

R9: (7 sc, 1 inc) 2x on body, 7 sc  
(joining body and left leg), 1 inc on  
body, 7 sc (joining body and right  
leg), 1 inc, (7 sc, 1 inc) 2x on body = 54  
sc.

R10 - 13 (4 rnds) = 54 sc.

Switch to color 6614.

R14: 54 sc.

## Head

Switch to Amigurumi 4456.

R1: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.  
 R2: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.  
 R3: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.  
 R4: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc.  
 R5: 6 sc, 1 inc = 48 sc.  
 R6 - 15 (10 rnds) = 48 sc.  
 Attach safety eyes between R11 & 12, 8 sts apart.  
 Use Charme 8990 to embroider eyebrows as shown in the picture.  
 Embroider mouth with 10 sts onto rnds 7 & 8.  
 R16: 6 sc, 1 dec = 42 sc.  
 R17: 5 sc, 1 dec = 36 sc.  
 R18: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc.  
 R19: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.  
 Insert some stuffing into head.  
 R20: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.  
 R21: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Start stem.  
 Switch to color 5398.  
 R22: 2 sc, 1 dec = 9 sc.  
 Set piece aside.  
 Use Amigurumi 4456 to make divisions onto head to shape pumpkin. Use tapestry needle to make 6 divisions starting at R1 up to R21. (See picture)  
 Return where you stopped.  
 R23: (BLO) 9 sc.  
 R24 & 25: 9 sc.  
 Insert stuffing into stem.  
 Fasten off in magic loop method. (Insert tapestry needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close hole).  
 Work in the front loops of R23: mk 4 leaves: 1 sc, (1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 picot, 1 dc, 1

hdc in the same base st) 4x.  
 Fasten off and weave in ends.


### Scarf

Use Amigurumi 5398 and knitting needles.  
 CO 10 sts onto needles.  
 Mk 80 rows in Stockinette st.  
 BO all sts but do not cut yarn.  
 Use crochet hook to make fringes (ch 8, join scarf with 1 sl st) 9x. Fasten off and do the same on the other end. Wrap around neck as shown in the picture and secure it with some sts.

**Coaster (mk 4)**

Use Amigurumi Glow. Crochet in the round.

R1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

R2: 6 inc = 12 sc.

R3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.

R4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.

R5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.

R6: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.

R7: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc.

R8: 6 sc, 1 inc = 48 sc.

R9: 7 sc, 1 inc = 54 sc.

R10: 8 sc, 1 inc = 60 sc.

R11: 9 sc, 1 inc = 66 sc.

R12: 1 sl st (2 hdc, 5 dc in the same base st, 2 hdc, sk 1 base st, 2 sl sts)3x, 4 sl sts, ch 5, sk 1 chain, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, sk 2 base sts, join base with 1 sl st, 4 sl sts. Crochet edge into motifs of rnd below: (ch 2, 1 sl st, sk central st between motifs.

Use Rubi color 8990 to embroider 4 different face expressions: angry, happy scared, puzzled. (See pictures)

Note: embroider eyes and mouth separately. Mk 1 eye and fasten off to avoid shades when glowing in the dark.





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
