Nautical patch pillow

Size: 15.75" x 15.75"

Level: Intermediate

Material

1 ball of Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4/6 in each color: 8001, 3501 and 2859.

Crochet hook G-6

1 pillow insert or polyester stuffing.

Tapestry needle

Scissors.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st

make: mk

skip: sk

chain: ch

slip st: sl st

single crochet: sc

double crochet: dc

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor.

Pillow

Front

Use color 8001, mk a magic ring.

Rnd 1: *ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc*, join color 2859 and rep from * to *, 1 dc into ch 3 from the beginning.

Rnd 2: turn piece to WS and continue working with color 2859, *ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1 (space), mk (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) into next loop* set color 2859 aside. Use color 8001 to close rnd 1 with 1 dc into blue chains from the beginning. Rep from * to *. End with 1 dc into white initial chains. Continue following chart 1.

Mk 4 squares - chart 1 (white and Navy) and 5 squares - chart 2 (white and red).

Use color 2856 to join squares and follow assembly chart.

Back

Use color 2856, mk a magic ring.

Rnd 1: *ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc*, join color 3501 and rep from * to *, 1 dc into the ch 3 (blue) from the beginning.

Rnd 2: turn piece to WS and continue working with color 3501, *ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1 (space), mk (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) into next loop* set color 3501 aside. Use color 2856 to close rnd 1 with 1 dc into ch 3 (red) from the beginning. Rep from * to *. End with 1 dc into navy ch 3 from the beginning. Continue following chart 4.

Contour joining front & back - crochet in the round - switch colors according chart 3 for front and chart 5 for back.

Rnd 1: join yarn at a corner, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) forming a shell, *mk 3 dc, ch 2 (space) into next space*, rep from * to * until next corner and mk (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) into corners and * to * on sides, close with 1sl st.

Continue following chart 3 for front and chart 5 for back switching colors accordingly.

Join panels into last rnd of front with 3 sc on sides.

To close pillow, mk a chain cord with color 2856 and criss cross into open side. Mk 4 tassels and insert into corners of pillow.




Chart 3 - Front contour





Size: 20.5" x 20.5"

Level: Intermediate

Material

1 ball of Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4/6 in each color: 8001, 3501 and 2859.

Crochet hook G-6

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st

make: mk

skip: sk

chain: ch

slip st: sl st

single crochet: sc

double crochet: dc

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor.

Rug

Crochet in the round - change colors according to chart.

Mk 8 squares - chart 1 (8001 & 2859)

Mk 8 squares - chart 2 (8001 & 3501)

Use color 8001. Mk a magic ring.

Rnd 1: *ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc*, switch to color 2859 and rep from * to *, mk 1 dc into ch 3 from the beginning in white.

Rnd 2: Turn piece to WS and continue working with color 2859: *ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1 (space), (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) into next loop, switch to color 8001 and close Rnd 1 with 1 dc into blue chains from the beginning. Rep from * to *, end with 1 dc into white chains from the beginning. Continue following chart 1.

Assembly: follow assembly chart and use color 2859 to join squares.

Contour - crochet in the round.

Start with color 8001.

Rnd 1: join yarn at any side, ch 6 + 1 dc into same base st forming a V-st. *sk 3 base sts, (1 dc, ch 3, 1 dc) in the same base st, rep from * to * until eor.

Close with 1 sl st.

Rnd 2: 1 sl st, ch 6 + 1 dc in the same base st forming a V-st, *sk 3 sts, (1 dc, ch 3, 1 dc) in the same base st*, rep from * to * until eor. Close with 1 sl st.

Fasten off.

Continue following chart 3 - countour - change colors accordingly.

Level: Advanced

Material

1 ball of Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4/6 color 3635
1 ball of Natural Cotton Multicolor Premium 4/6
colors 9459 & 9642
crochet hook G-6.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st
make: mk
skip: sk
chain: ch
slip st: sl st
single crochet: sc
double crochet: dc
Increase: inc
decrease: dec
round: rnd
end of row/rnd: eor.

POOLING


Pooling is a very particular technique because to get to the pattern you want, you have to take in consideration the amount of stitches for each color, having in mind that every artisan has a different tension when working. Some artisans work tightly and some loosely. To form desired Pooling pattern you have to keep the exact stitch number per color. To get to this amount of sts, you will have to crochet loosely or tightly and if the leftover color yarn is too long, you have to alternate single crochet and half double crochet stitches to get to the exact amount of stitches to form desired pattern. Placemat 1

This placemat is worked in sc with color 9642 following yarn color sequence.
Ch 42 + 1 ch to turn and work as follows: 3 sc = light blue, 3 sc = dark blue, 4 sc = red, 3 sc = dark blue, 3 sc = light blue, 5 sc = beige. Work 59 rows.

Contour: 1 rnd with 3635, 1 rnd with color 9642 and end with 1 rnd with color 3635.
Follow chart.



Level: Intermediate

Material

1 ball of Natural Cotton Maxcolor 4/6 in each color: 8001, 3402 and 2856.

Crochet hook E-4

1 pillow insert or polyester stuffing.

Tapestry needle

Scissors.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st

make: mk

skip: sk

chain: ch

slip st: sl st

single crochet: sc

end of row/rnd: eor.

Tapestry crochet

According to the tapestry crochet technique, you work with 2 strands of yarn in each row, switching colors according to chart. Work one color at a time, while keeping the other colors inside the sts throughout the work.

The color of the yarn is always changed in the last 2 loops of the stitch. In a correct color change, you have a stitch in a solid color and a new color on your hook.

Chart 1

Mk 2 panels - crochet back & forth.

Use color 3402.

Ch 88 + 1 to turn.

Row 1: start into 2nd chain from hook, 88 sc.


Rows 2 - 4: ch 1, 88 sc. Cut yarn.

Continue following chart 1 switching colors accordingly.

Assembly

Overlap panels (stars on top = one panel stars will be on top right and the other on top left so both sides will be right). Use tapestry needle and color 3402 to sew 3 sides and insert pillow or polyester stuffing before sewing last side. Fasten off.

Size: adjustable - each link = 2.75"

Level: Easy

Material

1 ball of Duna in each color: 800, 3542 and 2859.

Crochet hook D-3

2 D shape rings (approx. 1.25" width)

Leather straps

2 metal snap on for leather as shown in the picture.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st

make: mk

skip: sk

chain: ch

slip st: sl st

single crochet: sc

Increase: inc


decrease: dec

round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor.

Belt

This belt is worked in links. Follow chart to start. Mk 9 links in blue, 8 links in white and 8 links in red. Once all links are finished, fold them in half, insert one into the other forming a chain following this color sequence: *blue, white and red*. Once chain is complete, use color 8001 and mk 1 sc to close last link. Ch 80, turn and mk 1 row in sc. Use color 2859 to make second row in sc. Cut a piece of leather to 0.5" x 1.5" and insert this leather strap into last blue link and use snap to close. Cut another leather piece to 1" x 2.5" and insert this strap through 2 D-rings, fold leather strap and use snap to close. (see picture)

Size: 6

Level: Advanced

Material

2 balls of Anne in each color: 2856, 3402 and 8001.

Crochet hook D-3

Tapestry needle

Fabric to line dress

Paper, pencil, measuring tape and scissors.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st

make: mk

skip: sk

chain: ch

slip st: sl st

single crochet: sc

half double crochet: hdc

double crochet: dc

Increase: inc

decrease: dec

round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor.

2 dc cluster: 2 dc closed tog in the same base st.

3 dc cluster: 3 dc closed tog in the same base st.

FPdc: Instead of inserting your hook in the ch at the top of st, wind it in and out of the post below, then work your dc as normal.

BPdc: Instead of inserting your hook in the ch at the top of st, go behind with your hook and wind it in and out of the post below, then work your dc as normal.

Pattern A: follow chart 1

Pattern B: follow chart 2

Collar: follow chart 3

Gauge

21 S x 10 R = 4"/10 cm over chart 2 - Pattern B using hook D-3.

Transfer measurement chart to paper to guide you along. Arrows indicate direction.

Color per tiers:

Color 2856

Tiers: 1,5,9,13,17,21,25,28,32,36, 43, 47 and 51.

Color 8001

Tiers: 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 22, 24, 27, 29, 31, 33, 35, 37, 39, 40, 42, 44, 46, 48, 50, 52 and 54.

Color 3402

Tiers: 3, 7, 11, 15, 19, 23, 26, 30, 34, 38, 41, 45, 49 and 53.

Dress

Part 1 - crochet in the round - change colors according to description above.

Use color 2856. Start at hemline.

Ch 200, close ring with 1 sl st.

Follow Pattern A - chart 1 and rep sts and number of motifs per tier.

Tiers 1 - 15: 20 motifs

Tier 16: dec 1 motif on each side

Tiers 17 - 29: 18 motifs.

Part 2 - crochet front and back separately - crochet back and forth. Change colors according to description above.

Front continuation: follow Pattern B - chart 2 and rep sts.

Tier 30: 1/2 motif, 7 motifs, 1/2 motif

Tier 31: 7 motifs

Tiers 32 - 34: 1/2 motif, 5 motifs, 1/2 motif

Tiers 35 & 36: 5 motifs

Tier 37: 1/2 motif, 3 motifs, 1/2 motif

Tiers 38 & 39: 3 motifs, fasten off.

Back continuation: same as front. Fasten off and set piece aside.

Part 3

Right sleeve - crochet in the round - switch colors according to description above.

Start at cuff.

Ch 80, close ring with 1 sl st.

Follow Pattern A chart 1 and rep sts and number of motifs per tier.

Tiers 40 - 45: 8 motifs

Part 4 - continue crocheting back & forth

- follow chart 2 and rep sts and number of motifs per tier. Change colors according to description above

Tiers 46 & 47: 7 motifs

Tiers 48 & 49: 1/2 motif, 5 motifs, 1/2 motif

Tier 50: 5 motifs.

Tiers 51 & 52: 1/2 motif, 3 motifs, 1/2 motif

Tiers 53 & 54: 3 motifs. Fasten off and set piece aside.

Left sleeve - same as right.

Assembly and finishing:

Use tapestry needle and colors according each tier, sew sleeves onto raglan shape (7.5")

Collar - crochet in the round.

Join color 2856 at neckline.

Rnds 1 - 4: follow chart 3 (88 sts) and rep sts

Hemline crochet edge: Join color 2856 at hemline and mk 1 rnd in sc (177 sc), close rnd with 1 sl st.

Sleeve crochet edge: Join color 8001 at cuff and mk 1 rnd in sc (57 sc), close rnd with 1 sl st.

Lining: Use dress as a template. Mk a slip to wear underneath.





Chart 2 - Pattern B
